## Clean Corner - 90mt, 7b+ max.

Luca de Giorgi / Michele Caminati, 2020/2023. First free ascent: Michele Caminati, may 2023.

## Approach:

From Monticolo lake parking area, take the road that leads to the RAI antenna. Just before reaching the antenna leave the main road and continue to the right along the forest trail that leads to the top of the wall near the climbing route "Cojote." From the starting point of Cojote route, continue south for about 30 to 50 meters, where you will see a fixed rope attached to a tree marking the start of the route "Anrainerproblem." From here, continue a few more meters south, along the edge of the wall, until you see some small rock bands beside the forest. Start descending to the left of the rocks and you will soon notice a fixed rope tied to a tree. Rappel down this rope over an initial rocky drop, and once in the forest below, follow the descending trail to the right until you reach a final section of fixed rope that leads to the top of the dihedral. (GPS: 46°23'53.8"N, 11°17'32.5"E)

L1 7b+ 31mt, 9 bolts. Friends #0.25 (totem black) 2x #0.3, #0.5, small nuts.

**L2** 6b+ 15mt, 2 bolts. Friends #0.1 - #2 + #4 at the start.

**L3** 7a+ 15mt, 1 bolt. Small nuts, mirco nuts (**brass nuts**), **ball nuts #1 and #2**, friends 1x #0.1, 3x #0.2 (At the end of the pitch exit to the left and clip a bolt, to avoid placing protection or putting stress on a large block along the main dihedral: it holds well in place, but you never know.)

L4 6c+ 14mt: small and medium nuts, friends #0.2-0.5, 2x 0.75

**L5** 7a (offwidth!) 18mt: friends #0.4-#4. (of which 2x #0.75, at least 3x #1, better 4x, 3x #2, 2x #3) + micro friends 2x #0,2 and small nuts for the top section (or eventually friend #5)

Rappels: L5-L3 (32mt), L3-L1 (22mt), L1-Ground (31mt).

Anchors of L4 and L5 to equip (only two bolts in place), others are fully equipped.

**Material:** 70mt rope or two 50mt half ropes. Nuts, ball nuts and friends listed in pitch descriptions, at least 9 quickdraws, slings and carabiners to equip two anchors, jumar and gri-gri to access the top of the route and coming back up.

**Exposure:** east, sun until 12 / 13 approximately. Good in spring time. The wall is fairly well ventilated and goes in shade early, allowing for good climbing conditions until the peak of summer heat. However, it's not very suitable in late autumn or winter.

**Warning:** the only way out is from the top! Brass nuts or ball nuts are recommended to easily aid up the third pitch; otherwise bring a short piece of rope to fix it from the top. The final two pitches offer enjoyable crack climbing: challenging but easy to protect.

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## L5 18mt 7a (offwidth) small nuts, cams #0.2

L4 14mt 6c+ - small and medius cams #0.2 - #0.75

L3 15mt 7a+ - 1 bolt, cams #0 small nuts, brass nuts or balln

L2 15mt 6b+ - 2 bol cams #0.1 - #4

L1 31mt.7b+-9 bolts, cams #0.2- #0.5, small nut
